Recreation:

There are number of recreational activities within a short distance from Rodd's Brudenell River Resort. Along with golfing at the Brudenell River Golf Course, there are private sector operators which provide canoeing, sea kayaking, paddleboards and horseback riding. Nearby attractions include Georgetown, Cardigan, the Garden of The Gulf Museum, Brudenell Riding Stables and the Confederation Trail. There are 9 km of hiking trails at the Roma National Historic Site. Fishing is also an option in three local rivers, with an extended angling season for rainbow trout beginning on September 16<sup>th</sup>.
